Conditions for participation in the competition for Handicrafts Exhibition.


- The making of objects / handicrafts should be of innovative, creative and artistic in nature. It may also be of scientific temperament.
- Ready-made exhibits purchased from the market are not eligible for exhibition.
- Materials which are inflammable / explosive in nature, hazardous to the health / environment and unsafe to human life, should not be used.
- The participants can take part only in One Category.
- The employees, their wards / dependents may participate in their respective group. The names of the wards / dependents who are participating should be in the Pass Declaration.
- The prescribed applications are available from 20/03/2019 to 26/03/2019 during office hours at Shell & Fur welfare centres and TTC Office.
- Last Date for receipt of filled in application along with handicraft exhibits will be 30/03/2019 before 17.00Hrs.
- Handicraft objects / exhibits are to be physically Hand Made. Purchased models will be summarily rejected.
- The competition will be monitored by a scrutiny committee.
- The decision of the scrutiny committee will be final in allowing the participants into the competition.
- There will be 3 prizes (First, Second and Third) in each category for the best adjudged objects / handicrafts.
- The decision of committee for adjudging the best objects / handicrafts shall be final.

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- Categories for Handicrafts exhibition:
 - Needle & Embroidery work
 - Sculpture
 - Science Models
 - Doll Making
- Theme for Handicrafts exhibition:
 - Women Empowerment
 - Conservation of Natural Resources
 - Wealth out of waste
 - Artistic & Creative work

After completion of the exhibition, the exhibits can be collected back from TTC on nominated dates 05th, 6th and 7th April 2019 during office hours. Failing which, return of exhibits will not be guaranteed.
